

Return to school schedule from 1st June 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please see below the current arrangements for children returning to school from 1st June.

From this time we will be re establishing our high expectations of being in school whilst implementing the necessary safety measures. Children will need to wear full school uniform and have their complete school PE kit with them as well as a sunhat and sunscreen applied in the morning. Jackets should be, whenever possible, the type that can be folded and kept in the PE bag.

The groups have been reduced in numbers due to government guidance measures. The class groups for Year R and 6 will be managed by their class teacher but may not be in their own classroom. However, the curriculum will be mirrored and the same opportunities offered. We will be maintaining the learning grid however activities in school may vary to those planned for the learning at home. Due to the increased expectations of school staff (covering lessons in school and at home) responses from teachers for those children still working at home may not always be within a short time period due to staff teaching commitments in school. Curriculum in school will additionally be focussed on emotional recovery depending on the childrens need and preparation for the next stage in their school journey.

Once the children have been allocated a group with named adults, this will be maintained as far as staffing allows. This is to keep the groups in their own "bubble" as recommended.

Key worker groups will be in their own "bubbles" from 1st June to limit inter group contact.

<u>N.B The school is currently unable to accept further applications for places in school. Please do not</u> send your child to school without receiving confirmation.

Confirmation of expectations is as follows for children attending school from 1st June:-

- We ask all parents to show mutual respect to others in not waiting in groups and to leave the site immediately. Any contact with staff will need to be through the school office ; by email or telephone call.
- School times for dropping and collection will be posted in Google classrooms- Please abide by these times in respect of each other and only arrive for school within a few minutes of time stated. Note: we will be closing early each Friday.
- Safeguarding arrangements will be processed in line with normal school procedures.
- All children may only be accompanied by **one** adult.
- The school will assume that all personal details remain the same unless otherwise informed and that names on our record for collection remain as previously stated.
- It is more important than ever that pupils follow all school policies-the behaviour ladder will be amended to include anti social behaviour as being totally unacceptable with respect for the health and well being of each other.
- Mealtime arrangements remain the same with the inclusion of consideration for numbers in the dining hall. (Please note if a child wishes to change from a packed lunch to school dinner or vice-versa they may only do so at the beginning of each half term)
- Each child needs to bring their own named sports bottle of water.

- If bags are needed, this should be the type that can be folded up to fit in the PE bag (not Year Reception).
- Junior children will need to bring in their own named pencil case containing pencils (for writing and colouring), glue stick, white board pen and for years 5 and 6, handwriting pens. The pencil case will need to remain in school for the rest of the term.
- There will be no "in school clubs".
