



## Spirituality Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> May - 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter







Pope Francis has declared this Church year to be the Year of St. Joseph. In his Apostolic Letter, *Patris corde* ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows. Beginning in the Book of Genesis, human work has always been celebrated as a participation in God's creative work. In being steadfast in our daily labours, we answer God's command to care for the earth and to be productive. Saint Joseph is an excellent example of this. It is good to reflect that "...the Church considers it her task always to call attention to the dignity and rights of those who work, to condemn situations in which that dignity and those rights are violated, and to help to guide (social) changes so as to ensure authentic progress by man and society."
